

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR THE PROPOSED N.C. 150 IMPROVEMENTS FROM THE
N.C. 16 BYPASS IN CATAWBA COUNTY TO JUST WEST OF THE U.S. 21/N.C. 150 INTERCHANGE
IN MOORESVILLE, IREDELL COUNTY

TIP Project Nos. R-2307 & I-5717

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold two public hearings in August regarding the proposed project to widen of N.C. 150 to a multi-lane, median divided roadway. The project also includes the reconfiguration of the I-77/N.C. 150 interchange.

The purpose of the project is to improve traffic capacity and reduce congestion along N.C. 150 from the N.C. 16 Bypass to the U.S. 21/N.C. 150 interchange. An Environmental Assessment for this project was approved in March 2016. At this upcoming hearing the design alternatives will be presented to the public for review and comment.

The two Pre-Hearing Open Houses and Public Hearings are scheduled at the following times and locations:

NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed alternatives during the open house portion of the meeting. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the open house hours.

The formal presentation will include an explanation of the location and design of each proposed alternative, as well as information about the state-federal relationship, the right of way and relocation requirements, as well as procedures that will be part of the project. The presentation and comments received will be recorded and included in the alternative selection process.
