



ORDER

THIS MATTER was heard before the Superior Court, the Honorable Judge Gregory R. Hayes presiding over the November 2, 2015, Session of Superior Criminal Court held in Newton, North Carolina. Defendant was represented by Charles L Morgan, Jr. and plead guilty to Obtaining Property by False Pretense. Evidence in these cases is in the custody of the Catawba County Sherriff's Office and needs to be disposed of. The Court makes the following Findings of Fact:


1. Defendant obtained numerous items by false pretense at the expense of his employer, Steele Rubber Products, Inc., the victim.
2. Defendant was ordered by the court to pay restitution to the victim in the amount of \$59,911.35.
3. Moneys made from the auction of some of the items could provide some reimbursement to the victim.
4. Catawba County Assistant District Attorney Michelle Lippert and Attorney for the Defendant, Charles L. Morgan, Jr. consent to the Sheriff's office auctioning, or causing to be auctioned, items in evidence and the proceeds applied to restitution for the victim.
5. The time within which an appeal can be filed has expired and any items in evidence are no longer necessary for trial.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that:

1. The Catawba County Sherriff's Office shall auction off the items listed in Exhibit A, attached and incorporated herein and destroy the items in listed in Exhibit B, attached and incorporated herein.

2. All proceeds from the auctioned items shall be turned over to the Catawba County Clerk of Court who shall apply the monies toward the restitution due the victim, Steele Rubber Products, Inc.
