



How to Apply or Make a Referral

Visit Catawba County Social Services Monday-Friday 8 a.m.-5 p.m. to meet with an Intake Social Worker.

The person needing CAP/DA services does not have to be present. A representative may apply on his or her behalf.

The Community Alternatives Program is funded by Medicaid. CAP participants must be eligible for Medicaid and are subject to deductibles, co-payments, etc., as determined by Medicaid program guidelines.

Free Interpretation Services

If you do not speak English, or if you are deaf, hard of hearing, or deaf/blind, you can have interpretation services provided for you at no charge. Tell the person helping you that you need an interpreter.

What is CAP/DA?

The Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults (CAP/DA) is a special Medicaid program for disabled adults that provides services at home as an alternative to nursing home placement.

CAP/DA makes care at home a real possibility for many people who face nursing home placement.



Who Qualifies?

- Individual is at least 18 years old
- Lives in a private home
- Requires nursing home level of care (ICF or SNF)
- Is eligible for Medicaid under CAP/DA
- Can have their needs met at home while providing for their health, safety and well being within the Medicaid monthly cost limit.
- Ongoing, informal support from family and friends

What Services are Offered?

- Adult Day Health
- In-Home Aide Services (hours provided per client care plan)
- Specific Medical Supplies (i.e., incontinence supplies, nutritional supplements)
- Telephone alert
- Case management
- Home Mobility Aids (i.e., wheelchair ramps, handheld showers)
- Preparation and delivery of meals
- Respite Care
