iCARE TOUR TO OFFER A LOOK AT HUMAN SERVICE NEEDS IN CATAWBA COUNTY

HICKORY -- The iCare Tour will be held June 6 to give Catawba County residents an overview of the human service needs in the county, and how they can help.

This event is a narrated bus tour of six non-profit agencies and speakers from several human service agencies. The tour begins at St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Hickory at 8 a.m. and ends there at 4 p.m. with a roundtable discussion. Participants are provided with breakfast and lunch.

The tour will stop at the following locations: Family Care Center, Council on Adolescents, Greater Hickory Cooperative Christian Ministry, Hickory Soup Kitchen, Resource Warehouse and Gallery/Safe Harbor, and Sipe's Orchard Home Home-Houston Cottage. Each agency stop will feature speakers from additional agencies.
