Meals on Wheels meets an urgent need

Meals on Wheels meets an urgent community need by delivering professionally planned, well-balanced and nutritious meals to our homebound neighbors.

No income restrictions!

Short- or long-term service is available for seniors 60 years of age or older who are homebound and unable to access and prepare food for themselves.

Noon delivery provides lunch and the warmth of a smile from a friendly volunteer.

How can your company help?

Sponsor a volunteer team of your employees. A volunteer meal-delivering team from your business can make a difference and strengthen our community.

How do company teams work?

Each team consists of four or more people, including a leader who does the scheduling.

Working in teams, each person gives only one lunch hour a month.

Team members can deliver meals in pairs with one person acting as navigator while the other drives.

Using their own car, a team picks up the meals at a Meals on Wheels site and delivers 10-15 meals to individuals.

Pick-up times vary, based on location. Delivery is usually complete in about an hour.
