#### Hickory High Junioresettes Club Makes 107 Blankets for the Children's Advocacy & Protection Center

HICKORY -- The Children's Advocacy & Protection Center of Catawba County recently received 107 blankets lovingly made by the Hickory High Junioresettes Club.

The Club is sponsored by the Hickory Junior Woman's Club. Both Clubs work to make their community a better place to live. They accomplish this through committed volunteerism focusing on Arts, Conservation, Education, Home Life, International Affairs, and Public Relations. Members of the Hickory High Junioresettes Club must give 30 hours of service throughout the school year to remain an active member.

Under the supervision of Sarah White and Alison Teague, teachers at Hickory High School, the Junioresettes made 107 blankets that will be used for children who receive a medical exam at the CAPC. The child is able to select a blanket and then takes the blanket home.

The mission of the CAPC is to assure a comprehensive, culturally competent, multi-disciplinary team response to child victims of alleged sexual and severe physical abuse in a
