Dave in the Morning Goes to Jail to Support Meals on Wheels

Dave in the Morning is going to jail this Tuesday, August 7th. Dave is a radio personality featured in the Wacky Wake Up Crew on WNNC 1230am and 63 Big Ways 630am. His crime? He wants to raise gas money for the many generous volunteers who deliver Meals on Wheels to homebound seniors and disabled adults. Dave will be broadcasting live that morning from his cell at the new Catawba County Jail. Beginning at 5am, he will begin taking pledges to raise his "bond" for release. Listeners can also make pledges to keep him in jail. He will personally match all funds pledged toward his bond.

The Meals on Wheels program is run by The Catawba County Department of Social Services. Its purpose is to help meet the nutritional needs of seniors and disabled adults who are unable to prepare or obtain meals for themselves. The program serves over 300 citizens through the help of over 700 volunteers.

The Meals on Wheels is always looking for volunteers to deliver meals to home-bound seniors within Catawba County. With just one hour per month, volunteers can make a huge impact in the lives of some of our local elderly. Delivery routes are available in local communities including Hickory, Newton, Conover, Catawba, and Maiden. Volunteers must possess a valid driver's license.
