*Community Event to Honor Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.*

The “I Have a Dream” speech was a defining moment of the American Civil Rights Movement. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. delivered the speech on August 28, 1963, to over 250,000 civil rights supporters from the steps of the Lincoln Memorial during the March on Washington.
