NEWTON, NC – The Catawba County Library is the community’s place to connect, explore and grow. For example, the Catawba County Library enjoys an ongoing partnership with the NC Works Career Center helping connect people with jobs. **Every Wednesday, from 10 am to 2 pm**, a career specialist is available at the Main Library in Newton to assist people in finding a job, strengthening their resume or preparing for an interview. Stop by this Wednesday and let them help you prepare for your next job.

In addition to the onsite career assistance, the Catawba County Library will host an employment recruitment event for Home Instead Senior Care at the **Main Library in Newton on Thursday, October 15 from 10 am until 2 pm**. Home Instead Senior Care is hiring Certified Nurse Assistants/Aides (CNAs), Patient Care Assistants (PCAs), and companions to help people who are disabled, chronically ill, cognitively impaired, or elderly who need assistance with activities of daily living.

The library is an invaluable resource for anyone who needs help with completing an online job application or conducting a job search. The library offers free one-on-one session with a career specialist, computer classes and FREE access to computers, printers and the Internet. Most importantly, the library is committed to connecting people to jobs!
