Library announces staff changes

Catawba County Library System is undergoing some staff reassignments, according to Suzanne White, library director.



April Green will be serving as Youth Services librarian at Newton while Siobhan Loendorf will assume duties as branch manager at Sherrills Ford. The changes, effective Jan. 1, are prompted by the resignation of Richard Griffin, Youth Services librarian, who is moving out of state.

Green has served as branch librarian at Sherrills Ford for two years, and returns to the Youth Services post where she worked while in graduate school. She is a 16-year veteran of the library system and is a graduate of Lenoir-Rhyne University and holds a master of library science degree from East Carolina University. She returns to her post at Youth Services, her primary work interest. She resides in the Startown community.



Siobhan Loendorf joined the Catawba County Library System in 2011 as librarian and coordinator of computer classes and adult programming for all ages at Claremont and Conover branches. That post will be filled at a later date.

Loendorf holds a B.A. degree in French education from the University of North Carolina-Greensboro and a M.A. degree in library science from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Based in Sherrills Ford, she will be working closer to her home in the Denver area.
