OVERVIEW OF FINANCIAL IMPACT OF FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN ON COUNTY

For Catawba County Social Services:

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), which includes Child Protective Services, Foster Care Services and Electing County/ Work First cash payments and administration, which Serves over 300 citizens/month-a few working adults, but mainly children; (loss of \$234,000 per month);
- Social Services Block Grants, which includes Child Welfare Services including Foster Care and Adoptions, Adult Protective Services/Guardianship Services and Adult Day Care; (loss of \$44,000 per month);
- Child Care Development Fund, which includes Child Care Subsidy and administrative services for more than 1800 children each month (loss of \$475,000 per month);
- Community Services Block Grants, which include Community Action Agency/Poverty Prevention; (loss of \$16,700 per month);
- Home and Community Care Block Grants, which include Adult Day Care, In-Home Aide and Senior Transportation and Nutrition, and serves approximately 850 citizens per month (loss of \$67,917 per month); and
- the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program, which serves 1200 families. (loss of \$300,000 annually).

For Catawba County Public Health:

- Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program is a federal program that provides supplemental food, nutrition education and counseling to women, infants, and young children. (Over 4,100 participants in Catawba County. In fiscal year 2012-13, voucher redemption contributed over \$3 million to the local economy).
