| Services | Phone Number | Brief Description |
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| Adult Health Clinic | (828) 695-4445 | Sexually transmitted disease prevention and treatment, family planning and birth control. |
| Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP) | (828) 695-4445 | Women’s health screening, pap smear tests, clinical breast exams and mammograms for qualifying women between the ages of 40 and 64. |
| Care Coordination for Children (CC4C) | (828) 695-5800 | Developmental screenings, immunizations, family assessments, and educational services for children from birth to age 5. |
| Catawba County Health Partners | (828) 695-5818 | Facilitates community coalitions to help improve Catawba County’s health priorities. |
| Catawba Family Dentistry | (828) 695-5778 | Provided by Catawba Family Dentistry, general dental services for children between the ages of 1 through 21 and pregnant women covered by Medicaid. |
| Communicable Disease & Tuberculosis (TB) Program | (828) 695-5800 | Reportable disease surveillance, management and treatment, including outbreak monitoring and response. |
| Early Childhood Support Team <i>(Located at Partnership for Children)</i> | (828) 695-6590 | Services to childcare centers including health education, access to family health resources, and health plans for children with chronic illness. |
| Environmental Health <i>(Located at Government Center)</i> | (828) 465-8270 | Inspections for food and lodging establishments and water systems. Investigates environmental health complaints. |
| Health Promotion | (828) 695-5800 | Promoting healthy lifestyles through health education and community health improvement initiatives. |
| Immunization Clinic | (828) 695-5881 | Provides all required immunizations for adults and children (ages 2 months and up), flu shots, and vaccines recommended for travel outside the U.S. |
| Prenatal Services | (828) 466-7196 | Provided by Catawba Valley Medical Center (CVMC) to assure comprehensive prenatal and postpartum care and support services to women. |
| Pregnancy Care Management (OBCM) | (828) 695-5800 | Assistance to women during their pregnancy and up to 8 weeks after childbirth, including pregnancy-related education and connection with resources. |
| School Health | (828) 695-5800 | Access to preventive and acute health care for children in grades K-12, including early detection of health issues, treatment, case management services, and referrals. |
| WIC (Women, Infants, and Children) | (828) 695-5884 | A federal supplemental nutrition program for children up to age 5 and pregnant, postpartum and breastfeeding women. |
