

CONTRACTOR PREQUALIFICATION NOTICE
CATAWBA COUNTY JAIL EXPANSION (RFQ 18-1006)
November 27, 2017

Catawba County, North Carolina is seeking prequalification statements from general contractors for work to be performed on a Jail Expansion located in Newton, N.C. This project will be bid as a single-prime contract. Any contractor wishing to be prequalified for the work must complete the application and be approved by Catawba County for bidding.

The Catawba County Jail project is a 320-bed expansion of the existing jail that will also include shell space. The expansion of approximately 85,500 square feet will consist of two additional two-story housing buildings with a connection to the existing jail. Male general housing will have 4 – 32 bed units, medical/mental health housing will have 1 – 32 bed unit, male and female youthful offender housing will have 1 – 16 bed unit each, and there are 2 – 32 bed general housing units. The primary structure is masonry bearing walls and precast concrete.
