

Section 00800, Supplementary Conditions

- 1. Page 00800-16, paragraph 17.08 Wage Rates: delete this paragraph in its entirety.

Response to Questions Received

1. *Can you provide geotechnical investigation reports performed for the existing LFGTE Generation Facility?*

The County doesn't have any geotechnical investigation reports for the existing LFGTE generation facility.

2. *This Supplementary Conditions SC-6.02 C indicates working time is 5 days x 12 hrs. per week, per SC-6.02D Inspection overtime is rated at \$ 135/ Hr. after the regular working time. Question: Is it acceptable to assume that overtime fee will be assessed after 60 Hrs. of inspection including Saturday as a standard working day?*

Overtime costs will be assessed based upon the result of overtime work in excess of the regular working hours which are defined as 12 hours per day, Monday through Friday. Saturdays are not considered regular working days. Any Saturday work would need to be approved in advance.

3. *Supplementary Conditions SC-17.08 indicates the obligation to pay no less than minimum Wages Rates and copies of the wage schedules are included in Part II of the Supplementary Conditions. Question: Can you provide the Minimum Wages Schedule, as can't find them on the Bid documents?*

4. *Section 01102 Safety, Health & Emergency Response, Part 1.01 B 1: The Site Safety and Health Officer (SSHO) shall be assigned to the site on a full time basis. Question: Can you confirm that the SSHO can be the Contractor's Superintendent who has the H&S training qualifications?*

Yes, the full-time on-site Superintendent can serve as the SSHO as long as the person has the proper H&S training and up-to-date certifications. The person must be fully qualified and authorized to implement and enforce the Safety, Health, and Emergency Response Plan.
