

Informal Proposal for Clean-up of
Property on 4807 Old Catawba Road
Catawba, NC

Catawba County will receive informal proposals until 5:00 PM, Wednesday, October 3, 2007 in the office of the Purchasing Agent, Government Center, 100-A South West Boulevard, Newton, NC.

Contractor will be required to remove solid waste on the property and to make sure that Erosion Control Measures are put in place as needed after removing the Solid Waste (i.e. grass and hay).

All solid waste will go to the Catawba County Landfill. Fees will **NOT** be waived at the Landfill. Contractor shall coordinate with the Landfill debris delivery. **Do not include tipping fees in your cost proposal. Actual tipping fees will be reimbursed after they have been paid to the Landfill. Contractor must provide proof of actual tipping fee costs.**

Solid waste will be segregated according to Landfill requirements. Contractor shall coordinate with the Landfill debris delivery.

Code Compliance Officer will be on site during clean up.

A site visit will be conducted Monday, October 1, 2007 at 10:00 AM. A Code Compliance Technician will be on site to address any questions. Site map is attached. Questions concerning this project should be addressed to Ed Barton, Code Compliance Technician at 828-312-2292.

Insurance Requirements: A minimum of \$200,000 liability to include fire/legal liability, advertising injury liability, medical expenses liability, auto liability for business auto and worker's compensation if applicable. Catawba County shall be named as additionally insured; a copy of the certificate is required at time of bid award.

Contractor must begin the project within two weeks of contract. Contractor must finish the contract within two weeks of start date or pay liquidated damages of \$100 per day.

Additional information needed on an itemized invoice should reflect the following:

- Date upon which labor and materials were first furnished upon property.
- Date upon which labor or materials were last furnished upon property.
- General description of the labor performed or materials furnished including type of equipment used and the amount claimed.
- Copies of weight/load tickets from the Blackburn Landfill.

Catawba County reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.

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
