Is Catawba County wanting a semi-trailer to be staged at the location for a swap out method or is a live load option acceptable?

Response: We typically do live loads.

Is the vendor to provide boxes and pallets or does the SWA provide their own?

Response: We look to the vendor to supply.

Who was the vendor who collected electronics?

Response: Electronics Recyclers International, Inc. (ERI)

What is there an RFP for this service instead of utilizing the previous vendor?

Response: New pricing will be implemented; County wants to compare costs.

Is Catawba County able to double stack Gaylord boxes to load onto a trailer, which makes loads heavier?

Response: Yes

How many loads were sent out in 2017?

Response: 11 loads – 154 tons

How many loads were sent out in 2017?

Response: 8 loads – 102 tons

What is the average weight per load?

Response: Approximately 20,000 to 25,000 pounds

Are you able to provide the past few load reports from the previous vendor to give an idea of the breakdowns, weights, etc.?
