The project generally consists of the following:

The project consists of the replacement of three existing truck scales and installation of back-up power generators at the Blackburn Sanitary Landfill in Catawba County, North Carolina. The Work to be performed under this Contract generally includes the manufacture, delivery, installation and certification of three new above-ground hydrostatic truck scales with all appurtenances including digital scale indicators and all other required equipment; two back-up power generators and propane tanks with all appurtenances; supporting structural and electrical work, and other incidentals as shown on the Drawings and noted in the Specifications.

The project consists of the replacement of the existing three truck scales with hydrostatic truck scales and the installation of two back-up power generators at the Blackburn Sanitary Landfill in Catawba County, North Carolina.

Contract Documents are available. Only complete sets of Contract Documents will be issued. Contract Documents consisting of Contract Drawings and Project Manual must be obtained from Accent Imaging, 725 11th Ave Blvd SE, Hickory NC 28602, 828-322-5050 at their established production costs. This is not a deposit job and no refunds will be issued after successful delivery of project documents. Bid documents are also available for examination at the County Purchasing Office, Catawba County Government Center.

A **non-mandatory Pre-bid Conference** will be held at **10:00 a.m.** on **January 24, 2018** at the Catawba County Blackburn Landfill conference room, 4017 Rocky Ford Road, Newton, NC 28658.

Catawba County will receive sealed bids for the Catawba County Blackburn Landfill Scale Replacement Project, Bid Number 18-1011, in the 2nd floor conference room, Government Center, 25 Government Drive, Newton, NC 28658 until 2:00 p.m., local prevailing time, on **February 6, 2018**. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. The clock in the 2nd floor conference room shall determine the time of receipt.

If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid shall be marked on the exterior: Catawba County Blackburn Landfill Scale Replacement Project (Bid #18-1011) and with the name, address, and North Carolina Contractor License Number of the Bidder. The sealed envelope shall be addressed to Catawba County, attention of Mrs. Debbie Anderson, Purchasing Manager, 25 Government Drive (physical address), PO Box 389 (mailing address), Newton, NC 28658.

To qualify, all bids shall be submitted using bid forms contained in the Contract Documents, and submittal of all information requested in the Instructions to Bidders (00100). Incomplete or segregated bids will not be accepted.

Questions regarding the intent or Scope of Work must be delivered in writing to Martin Sanford, PE, via e-mail sanfordmd@cdmsmith.com and, to be given consideration, must be **received** at least eight (8) days prior

to the date fixed for the opening of bids. Appropriate responses, where required, will then be issued by addendum to all plan holders prior to the date scheduled for submittal of bids.

All bids must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check or bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the total base bid amount made payable to Catawba County. Said deposit shall be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the Contract within fifteen calendar days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.

A Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment bond, each in the amount equal to 100% of the Contract Sum will be required to be furnished at the execution of the Contract Documents.

No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 45 days after receipt of bids except as provided in Instructions to Bidders. Bidders are also notified that applicable provisions of Chapter 87 of the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina shall be observed in the receiving of bids and awarding of contracts for the Work.

Bidders must be licensed contractors in the State of North Carolina per classifications stated in Paragraph 2.0 in Section 00420.

The Owner reserves the right to waive informalities and to reject any and/or all bids.
