Polling Place Buffer Zones for Catawba County Polling Locations

Catawba County polling places and a description of each buffer zone concerning Election Day electioneering.

The Catawba County Board of Elections has stated that all persons or groups of people engaging in election activity must not obstruct sidewalks or entrances to the buildings. Signs should not be placed at polling locations until the day before the election and must be removed when polls close at 7:30pm election day. Size of signs are limited to standard political yard-sign sizes only. Vehicles carrying or displaying large signs are not allowed at polling location sites. Additional restrictions may be imposed by property owners.

The Catawba County Board of Elections has stated that all persons or group of persons engaing in election activity must not obstruct sidewalks or entrances to the buildings. Signs may not be placed at one-stop locations until the day before voting begins and must be removed the final day of early voting; however, if the early voting site is also an election day polling location, signs may remain in place through election day. Size of signs are limited to standard political yard-sign sizes only. Vehicles carrying or displaying large signs are not allowed at polling location sites. Additional restrictions may be imposed by property owners.
