

Summer programs and activities take place from June through early August. The adventure begins with a Family Fun Day at the Sherrills Ford-Terrell Branch on May 11 and then join us for a

system-wide celebration at Conover Station on Friday, June 7 from 4-6 pm with a sneak peek of programs, photo op with Smokey the Bear, crafts, games, and family fun!
