RIVERBEND PARK is a 690-acre natural playground with 20.22 miles of wooded trails and 1.25 miles of shoreline along the scenic Catawba River. Enjoy your visit as you explore our:

- 2-acre off-leash dog park
- Leashed dog walking
- Canoe & kavak access

PARK RULES

Please observe our park rules to ensure your visit is safe and enjoyable.
Thank you for helping us protect our natural heritage.

- River Access: No swimming, wading, or walking on rocks in the river.
- Camping and Fires: Camping is not allowed. Fires are only allowed in grills.
- Dogs: Must have a valid rabies tag. Dogs outside the fenced dog park must be on leash.
- Fishing: Permitted only from banks or observation platform and only during park hours. NC Wildlife Resources Commission regulations apply.
- Trash: Please throw trash in proper receptacles located throughout the park.
- Natural Resources: The removal of any plant, animal or artifact is not allowed.
- Children: Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Alcohol and Tobacco: Tobacco use and the possession or drinking of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.
- Guns and Fireworks: Fireworks, firearms and all other weapons are not allowed. Carrying legally
 permitted concealed handguns in Catawba County Parks is allowed.
- Motorized Vehicles: Motorized bikes, golf carts, four wheelers and other off-road vehicles are not allowed.
- Drones: Not allowed.
- Hunting and Trapping: Not allowed. All Catawba County Parks are wildlife reserves.

PARK FACILITIES FEES

Open Shelter Reservation = \$20/hour (2 hour minimum)
Education/Meeting Facility = \$100 half day/\$150 full day
