


The Catawba County Library is excited to offer a new experience for our youngest learners to connect, explore, and grow!

All Catawba County Library locations will be hosting rotating Pre-K STEAM programs for preschoolers and their caregivers. This is an opportunity for children age 2-5 to explore science, technology, engineering, art and math concepts on a level they can appreciate. Preschoolers are naturally curious and eager to explore their surroundings. The library's STEAM programs are designed around how children learn so parents and caregivers are encouraged to let their children take the lead in learning through discovery. Learning through play will introduce foundational concepts and vocabulary that will support future learning and interest in these fields.

STEAM activities are designed to:

- Stimulate curiosity
- Provoke questions
- Build confidence in abilities
- Encourage observations
- Allow children to investigate the world around them
- Provide hands-on interactive experiences
- Encourage resilience in the face of challenges
- Show that it's okay to make mistakes

Pre-K STEAM programs will be offered at a different location across the county each week. These programs will be facilitated by a librarian who will be present to answer



Children's earliest experiences shape how their brains are wired creating a foundation for all future learning. Starting from birth, brain connections are built through a child's everyday experiences – by positive interactions with their parents and caregivers, and by using their senses to interact with the world around them. Engaging in STEAM related activities fosters

curiosity, introduces new vocabulary, and encourages experimentation and exploration.
