Bids received after this date and time will not be considered and will be returned to the Bidder unopened.

Instructions for the preparation and submission of a Bid are contained in the following IFB. Please read the entire document carefully.

Any changes to the terms, conditions or specifications stated in this IFB will be documented in a written addendum, issued by the Catawba County Purchasing Manager. These addenda will be posted on the internet at <http://www.catawbacountync.gov/county-services/purchasing/bid-notices/> Each Bidder is required to acknowledge receipt of all addenda using the space provided on the enclosed Bid Submission Form. Please note that we may not consider any Bid that fails to acknowledge receipt of each issued addendum. In addition, the County reserves the right to reject any and all Bids and to waive informalities as may be permitted by law.

1.0 PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND

This Invitation for Bids is being issued for the purpose of establishing a contract for the purchase of medical supplies and pharmaceuticals for use by Catawba County Emergency Medical Services Division.

Bids must be submitted in accordance with the terms and conditions of this IFB and any addenda issued hereto.

2.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

2.1 INVITATION FOR BIDS DOCUMENT

The IFB is comprised of the base IFB document, any attachments, and any addenda released before the Contract award. All attachments and addenda released for this IFB in advance of any Contract award are incorporated herein by reference.

2.2 NOTICE TO VENDORS REGARDING IFB TERMS AND CONDITIONS

It shall be the Vendor's responsibility to read the IFB, Instructions to Bidders, all relevant exhibits and attachments, and any other components made a part of this IFB and comply with all requirements and specifications herein. Vendors are also responsible for obtaining and complying with all addenda and other changes that may be issued concerning this IFB.

If Vendors have questions, issues, or exceptions regarding any term, condition, or other component with this IFB, those **must** be submitted as questions in accordance with the instructions in Section 2.4 BID QUESTIONS. If the County determines that any changes will be made resulting from the questions asked, then such decisions will be communicated in the form of an IFB addendum. The County may also elect to leave open the possibility for post-contract negotiation and amendment of specific provisions of the Contract that have been addressed during the question and answer period. Vendor's bid shall constitute a firm offer. By execution and delivery of a bid in response to this IFB, the Vendor agrees that any additional or modified terms and conditions, whether submitted purposefully or inadvertently, shall have no force or effect, and will be disregarded. Noncompliance with, or any attempt to alter or delete, this paragraph shall constitute sufficient grounds to reject Vendor's bid as nonresponsive.

No information, instruction or advice provided orally or informally by any County personnel, whether made in response to a question or otherwise concerning this IFB, shall be considered authoritative or binding. Bidders shall rely only on written material contained in an Addendum to this IFB.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This is an absolute requirement. Bidder shall bear the risk for late submission due to unintended or unanticipated delay—whether delivered by hand, U.S. Postal Service, courier or other delivery service. **It is the Bidder’s sole responsibility to ensure its bid has been submitted to this Office by the specified time and date of opening.** The date and time of submission will be recorded on each bid when received, and any bid received after the bid submission deadline will be rejected.

2.6 BID CONTENTS

Bidders shall populate all attachments of this IFB that require the Bidder to provide information and shall include an authorized signature where requested. Bidder response to this IFB shall include each of the following items and these items should be arranged in the following order:

3.0 METHOD OF AWARD AND BID EVALUATION PROCESS

3.1 METHOD OF AWARD

Contract, sample of which is attached hereto as Attachment F, will be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive Bidder or Bidders, taking into consideration quality, performance, and the evaluation criteria set out in this solicitation. Prospective Bidders shall not be discriminated against on the basis of any prohibited grounds as defined by Federal and State law.

While the intent of this IFB is to award a Contract(s) to a single Bidder for all line items County reserves the right to make separate awards to different Bidders for one or more line items, to not award any portion of the goods or to cancel this IFB in its entirety without awarding a contract, if it is considered to be most advantageous to the County to do so. The County reserves the right to waive any minor informality or technicality in bids received as may be permitted by law.

3.2 BID EVALUATION PROCESS

The County will review all Bidder responses to this IFB to confirm that each one complies with the specifications and requirements of the IFB.

Bids are requested for the items as specified, or item(s) equivalent in design, function and performance. The County reserves the right to reject any bid on the basis of fit, form and function as well as cost. All information furnished on this bid may be used as a factor in determining the award of this contract.

The County will conduct an evaluation of Bids, as follows:

- a) Bids shall be received from each responsive Bidder in the method stated in section 2.5.
- b) All bids shall be received by the County not later than the date and time specified on the cover sheet of this IFB, or as modified by a bid addendum.

- c) At the date and time specified as the bid opening, the bid responses from each responding Bidder will be opened publicly.
- d) At its option, the County may request clarifications, oral presentations or discussion with any or all Bidders in order to clarify or to amplify the materials presented in any part of the bid or requested in the IFB. Bidders are cautioned, however, that the County is not required to request presentations or other clarification, and often does not. Therefore, all bids should be complete and reflect the most favorable terms available from the Bidder. Bid prices cannot be altered or modified as part of a clarification.
- e) Bids will generally be evaluated based on completeness, content, cost and responsibility of the Bidder to supply the requested goods and services. Specific evaluation criteria are listed in Section 3.1 METHOD OF AWARD.
- f) Upon completion of the evaluation process, the County will make Award(s) based on the evaluation and post the award(s) to the Catawba County website under Purchasing and the IFB number for this solicitation. Award of a Contract to one Bidder does not mean that the other bids lacked merit, but that, all factors considered, the selected bid was deemed most advantageous and represented the best value to the County.
- g) Bidders are cautioned that this is a request for offers, not an offer or request to contract, and the County reserves the unqualified right to reject any and all bids at any time if such rejection is deemed to be in the best interest of the County.

3.3 INTERPRETATION OF TERMS AND PHRASES

This Invitation for Bids serves two functions: (1) to advise potential Bidders of the parameters of the solution being sought by the County; and (2) to provide (together with other specified documents) the terms of the Contract that results from this procurement. The use of phrases such as “shall,” “must,” and “requirements” are intended to create enforceable contract conditions. In determining whether bids should be evaluated or rejected, the County will take into consideration the degree to which Bidders have proposed or failed to propose solutions that will satisfy the County’s needs as described in the Invitation for Bids. Failure to comply with any single requirement, if determined to be essential, may result in the County exercising its discretion to reject a bid in its entirety.

4.0 REQUIREMENTS

This Section lists the requirements related to this IFB. By submitting a bid, the Bidder agrees to meet all stated requirements in this Section as well as any other specifications, requirements and terms and conditions stated in this IFB. If a Bidder is unclear about a requirement or specification or believes a change to a requirement would allow for the County to receive a better bid, the Bidder is urged and cautioned to submit these items in the form of a question during the question and answer period in accordance with Section 2.4.

4.1 PRICING

The County is requesting a fixed unit price per item for the Core Items listed in ATTACHMENT D: MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND PHARMACEUTICALS - PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS AND PRICING FORM and a fixed percentage discount from the List Price (list less discount) included in the Company’s most current full line catalog for (b)

all other items (Non-Core Items) in your catalog, ATTACHMENT E: NON-CORE ITEMS FIXED PERCENTAGE DISCOUNT. To calculate EXT PRICE on the pricing form, multiply Unit Price by Last FY QTY. All pricing under this contract shall include shipping and handling, delivery, any discounts, Bidder markup/profit, item cost and storage. No other charges are allowed. DO NOT include taxes in your pricing.

4.2 PLACEMENT OF ORDERS:

All orders will be placed by designated County personnel on an as-needed basis for the quantity required at the time, during the term of the Contract. Orders will be placed by means of a purchase order or other approved authorization method.

4.3 PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

CONDITION AND PACKAGING

All containers and packaging shall be suitable for handling, storage or shipment, without damage to the contents. The Bidder will be responsible for confirming that packing is sufficient to ensure that all the materials arrive at the correct destination in an undamaged condition, ready for their intended use.

MARKING

All containers shall be clearly identified with the County purchase order number and marked with Emergency Services Department. Packing lists must be affixed to each carton, identifying all contents included in the carton. If more than one carton is shipped, each carton must be numbered and must state the number of that carton in relation to the total number of cartons shipped (i.e. 1 of 4, 2 of 4, etc.).

SHIPPING

The Bidder shall follow all shipping instructions included in the IFB, the County's purchase order and/or in the Contract.

4.4 ACCEPTANCE OF PRODUCTS

The products delivered under this Contract shall remain the property of the Bidder until the County physically inspects and accepts the products. In the event products provided to the County do not comply with the Contract, the County shall be entitled to terminate the Contract upon written notice to the Bidder and return such products (and any related goods) to the Bidder at the Bidder's expense. The remedies stated in this Section are in addition to and without limitation of any other remedies that the County may have under the Contract, at law or in equity.

4.5 GUARANTEE

Unless otherwise specified by the County, the Bidder unconditionally guarantees the materials and workmanship on all products. If, within the guarantee period any defects occur due to a faulty product, the Bidder at its expense, shall repair or adjust the condition, or replace the product to the complete satisfaction of the County.

4.6 NO LIENS

All Products shall be delivered and shall remain free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.

4.7 INVOICES

Bidder shall invoice the County. The standard format for invoicing shall be single invoices, meaning that the Bidder shall provide the County with an invoice for each order. Invoices shall include detailed line item information to allow County to verify pricing at the point of receipt matches the correct price from the original date of order. At a minimum, the following fields shall be included on all invoices:

Bidder's Billing Address, Customer Account Number, Order Date, Customer's Order Number, Manufacturer Part Numbers, Bidder Part Numbers, Item Descriptions, Price, Quantity, and Unit of Measure.

The County is not tax exempt from sales tax. Bidder shall include all applicable State and County sales taxes itemized on the invoice and not combined with the cost of the goods. Payment of invoices shall be due within thirty (30) days after the County has received the goods and received an accurate, properly submitted invoice.

4.8 TRANSPORTATION

The Bidder shall deliver Free-On-Board (FOB) Destination to the County with all transportation costs included in the total bid price.

4.9 AUTHORIZED RESELLER

The Bidder shall be authorized by the manufacturer to distribute or resell the products offered in this IFB. The Bidder shall provide with its bid response a signed statement from the manufacturer confirming authorization. Failure to provide this statement shall constitute sufficient grounds for rejection of Bidder's offer, at the discretion of the County.

4.10 COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

All products delivered under this Contract shall be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances. In performing the Contract, the Bidder shall obtain and maintain all licenses and permits, and comply with all federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances.

4.11 QUALITY

Unless this Contract specifically states otherwise for a particular item, all components used to manufacture or construct any supplies, materials, equipment or products provided under this Contract shall be: (a) new; (b) the latest model; (c) of the best quality and highest grade workmanship; and (d) in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and requirements. By "new", the County means that the item has been recently produced and has not been previously sold or used.

4.12 QUALITY ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION

It is the responsibility of the County to inspect all materials, supplies and equipment upon delivery to ensure compliance with the contract requirements and specifications.

INVOICES WILL NOT BE PAID BY THE COUNTY UNTIL AN INSPECTION HAS OCCURRED, AND THE GOODS HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED.

4.13 REFERENCES

Bidders shall provide at least three (3) references for which it has provided goods and services of substantially the same features and quantity to those solicited herein. The County shall contact one or more of these users to determine the goods provided are substantially similar to those bid herein and Bidder’s performance has been satisfactory. Information obtained will be considered in the evaluation of the bids.

4.14 FINANCIAL STABILITY

Each Bidder shall certify it is financially stable by completing the ATTACHMENT C: CERTIFICATION OF FINANCIAL CONDITION. The County is requiring this certification to minimize potential performance issues from contracting with a Bidder that is financially unstable. This Certification shall be deemed continuing, and from the date of the Certification to the expiration of the Contract, the Bidder shall notify the County within thirty (30) days of any occurrence or condition that materially alters the truth of any statement made in this Certification

5.0 PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION AND SPECIFICATIONS

5.1 MAKE AND MODEL

Except for items that do not provide an option to propose a substitution on ATTACHMENT D: MEDICAL SUPPLIES AND PHARMACEUTICALS - PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS AND PRICING FORM, the Manufacturer’s name, Bidder Name and model/catalog numbers used in the IFB are for the sole purpose of identification and to establish general quality level desired. Such references are not intended to be restrictive and comparable products of other manufacturers will be considered. However, Bidders are cautioned that any deviation from the specifications of the identified items are required to be pointed out in their bid. Bidder may be required to provide a sample of the proposed substitution and sufficient documentary evidence to demonstrate the qualitative, functional, operational, organizational, and conformational equivalence of the bid item to the identified item.

5.2 DEVIATIONS

The nature of all deviations from the *Specifications* and *Requirements* listed herein shall be clearly described by the Bidder. Otherwise, it will be considered that items offered by the Bidder are in strict compliance with the *Specifications* and *Requirements*, and the successful Bidder shall be held responsible for supplying conforming goods. Deviations shall be explained in detail below or on an attached sheet. However, no implication is made or intended by the County that any deviation will be acceptable.

ATTACHMENT A: INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

1. **READ, REVIEW AND COMPLY:** It shall be the Bidder's responsibility to read this entire document, review all enclosures and attachments, and any addenda thereto, and comply with all requirements specified herein.
2. **LATE BIDS:** Late bids, regardless of cause, will not be opened or considered, and will automatically be disqualified from further consideration. It shall be the Bidder's sole responsibility to ensure the timely delivery of bids at the designated office by the designated time.
3. **ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION:** The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality in bids and, unless otherwise specified by the Bidder, to accept any item in the bid. If either a unit price or an extended price is obviously in error and the other is obviously correct, the incorrect price will be disregarded. Regardless of error or omission, a Bidder shall not be permitted to increase its pricing after the deadline for submitting bids.
4. **BASIS FOR REJECTION:** The County reserves the right to reject any and all offers, in whole or in part, by deeming the offer unsatisfactory as to quality or quantity, delivery, price or service offered, non-compliance with the requirements or intent of this solicitation, lack of competitiveness, error(s) in specifications or indications that revision would be advantageous to the County, cancellation or other changes in the intended project or any other determination that the proposed requirement is no longer needed, limitation or lack of available funds, circumstances that prevent determination of the best offer, or any other determination that rejection would be in the best interest of the County.
5. **EXECUTION:** Failure to execute Attachment B: Bid Submission Form in the designated space shall render bid non-responsive, and it will be rejected.
6. **INFORMATION AND DESCRIPTIVE LITERATURE:** Bidder shall furnish all information requested and in the spaces provided in this document. Further, if required elsewhere in this bid, each Bidder shall submit with its bid any sketches, descriptive literature and/or complete specifications covering the products and services offered. Failure to comply with these requirements shall constitute sufficient cause to reject a bid without further consideration.
7. **CERTIFICATE TO TRANSACT BUSINESS IN NORTH CAROLINA:** As a condition of contract award, each Bidder shall have received, and shall maintain throughout the term of the Contract, a Certificate of Authority to Transact Business in North Carolina from the North Carolina Secretary of State, as required by North Carolina law.
8. **HISTORICALLY UNDERUTILIZED BUSINESSES:** The County is committed to retaining Bidders from diverse backgrounds, and it invites and encourages participation in the procurement process by businesses owned by minorities, women, disabled, disabled business enterprises and non-profit work centers for the blind and severely disabled. In particular, the County encourages participation by Bidders certified by the State Office of Historically Underutilized Businesses, as well as the use of HUB-certified Bidders as subcontractors on County contracts.

9. WITHDRAWAL OF BID: Bids that have been delivered by hand, U.S. Postal Service, courier or other delivery service may be withdrawn only in writing and if receipt is acknowledged by the office issuing the IFB prior to the time for opening bids identified on the cover page of this IFB (or such later date included in an Addendum to the IFB). Written withdrawal requests shall be submitted on the Bidder's letterhead and signed by an official of the Bidder authorized to make such request. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for a period of ninety (90) days.

10. INFORMAL COMMENTS: The County shall not be bound by informal explanations, instructions or information given at any time by anyone on behalf of the County during the competitive process or after award. The County is bound only by information provided in writing in this IFB and in formal Addenda issued through the County's website.

11. COST FOR BID PREPARATION: Any costs incurred by Bidder in preparing or submitting offers are the Bidder's sole responsibility; the County will not reimburse any Bidder for any costs incurred or associated with the preparation of bids.

12. BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIVE: Each Bidder shall submit with its bid the name, address, and telephone number of the person(s) with authority to bind the firm and answer questions or provide clarification concerning the firm's bid.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this the ___ day of November 2025, by and between CATAWBA COUNTY, a body politic, (hereinafter “County”) and _____, a North Carolina corporation (hereinafter “Contractor”).

STATEMENT OF BACKGROUND AND INTENT

- A. County issued an Invitation for Bids (IFB #: 26-1004) dated September 18, 2025, requesting bids from qualified firms to provide Catawba County Emergency Medical Services with medical supplies and pharmaceuticals, hereafter referred to as “Products”. The Invitation for Bids, together with all attachments and addenda, are referred to as the “IFB”.
- B. Contractor submitted a bid in response to IFB #: 26-1004 on October 16, 2025. The bid, together with all attachments, is referred to as the “Bid.”
- C. County awarded this Contract to Contractor to provide medical supplies and pharmaceuticals to County in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of the covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

1. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Contract Documents consist of this Contract, IFB, Addendum __, Contractor’s Bid Response dated October 16, 2025, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and modifications approved in writing by both parties and issued after execution of this Contract, all of which form the Contract and are incorporated herein, and are as fully a part of this Contract as if attached. If any provision in this Contract conflicts with any provision in any of the other Contract Documents, the provision contained in this Contract shall control.

2. TERM

The term of this Contract shall be for a period of three (3) years beginning November 16, 2025 and expiring November 15, 2028. County, at its option, may extend this Contract, consisting of the same terms and conditions, for two (2) additional one-year periods.

3. CONTRACT SUM

The Contract Sum is an annual amount and shall not exceed _____ (\$ _____) per fiscal year.

4. PRODUCT PRICE INCREASES

Price increases will only be considered at contract renewal and in circumstances where a manufacturer increase exceeds the contracted amount for a specific item. In this situation, and with documentation from the manufacturer of the item and the price increase, County will consider a price adjustment on that item. Contractor must make the request to County in writing

providing the justification for the increase and documentation from the manufacturer. Prices for products unaffected shall not be subject to an adjustment. Any price increase will not be retroactive.

5. AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE PRODUCTS

Contractor shall provide the Products in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

6. PRICING

This Contract is a fixed unit price per item for the Core Items listed in Exhibit A; and a fixed percentage discount from the List Price (list less discount) included in the Contractor's most current full line catalog for other items (Non-Core Items) in the catalog, listed in Exhibit A. Excluded from this discount are certain product categories or manufacturer products. This exclusion list is included in Contractor's bid response. All pricing under this Contract shall include shipping and handling, delivery, vendor markup/profit, item cost and storage. No other charges are allowed.

7. PLACEMENT OF ORDERS

All orders will be placed by designated County personnel on an as needed basis for the quantity required at the time during the term of the Contract. Orders will be placed by means of a purchase order or other approved authorization method. No minimum quantities are required at any time.

8. PREPARATION FOR DELIVERY

CONDITION AND PACKAGING

All containers and packaging must be suitable for handling, storage or shipment, without damage to the contents. The Contractor is responsible for confirming that packing is sufficient to assure all the materials arrive at the correct destination in an undamaged condition ready for their intended use.

SHIPPING

The Contractor must follow all shipping instructions included in the IFB, County's purchase order and in this Contract.

9. ACCEPTANCE OF PRODUCTS

The products delivered under this Contract shall remain the property of Contractor until County physically inspects, actually uses and accepts the products. In the event products provided to County do not comply with the Contract, County shall be entitled but not required to terminate the Contract upon written notice to Contractor and return such products (and any related goods) to Contractor at Contractor's expense. The remedies stated in this Section are in addition to and without limitation of any other remedies that County may have under this Contract, at law or in equity.

10. GUARANTEE

Unless otherwise specified by County, Contractor unconditionally guarantees the materials and workmanship on all products. If any defects occur due to a faulty product, Contractor at its expense, shall repair or adjust the condition, or replace the product to the complete satisfaction of County.

11. NO LIENS

All Products shall be delivered and shall remain free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.

12. INVOICES

Contractor must invoice County. The standard format for invoicing is single invoices meaning Contractor will provide County with an invoice for each order. Invoices must include detailed line item information to allow County to verify pricing at point of receipt matches the correct price from the original date of order. At a minimum, the following fields must be included on all invoices:

Contractor's Billing Address, Customer Account Number, Order Date, Customer's Order Number, Manufacturer Part Numbers, Contractor Part Numbers, Item Descriptions, Price, Quantity, and Unit of Measure.

Contractor must include all applicable State and County sales taxes itemized on the invoice and not combined with the cost of the goods. Payment of invoices shall be due within thirty (30) days after County has received the goods and received an accurate, properly submitted invoice.

13. TRANSPORTATION

Contractor must deliver Free-On-Board (FOB) Destination to County with all transportation costs included in unit prices referenced in Exhibit A.

14. AUTHORIZED RESELLER

Contractor must be authorized by the manufacturer to distribute or resell the products offered in this IFB. Contractor must provide County a signed statement from the manufacturer confirming authorization.

15. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

All products delivered under this Contract must be in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances. In performing the Contract, Contractor shall obtain and maintain all licenses and permits, and comply with all federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances.

16. QUALITY

Unless this Contract specifically states otherwise for a particular item, all components used to manufacture or construct any supplies, materials or equipment or products provided under this Contract must be: (a) new; (b) the latest model; (c) of the best quality and highest grade workmanship; and (d) in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws,

regulations and requirements. New means that the item has been recently produced with adequate shelf life and has not been previously sold or used.

17. QUALITY ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION

INVOICES WILL NOT BE PAID BY THE COUNTY UNTIL AN INSPECTION HAS OCCURRED, AND THE GOODS ACCEPTED.

18. PROJECT MANAGER AND CUSTOMER SERVICE

Contractor must designate and make available to County a single point of contact for contract related issues and issues concerning performance, progress review, scheduling and any service required.

19. PRODUCT RECALL

Contractor expressly assumes full responsibility for prompt notification to the County of any product recall in accordance with the applicable state or federal regulations. Contractor must promptly replace any such products at no cost to County.

20. AMENDMENT

This Agreement may not be amended orally or by performance. Any amendment must be in writing and executed by duly authorized representatives of County and Contractor.

21. CONTROLLING LAW

The terms of the Contract that result from this procurement are governed by the laws and regulations of the State of North Carolina, venue Catawba County.

22. E-VERIFY

Contractor must comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes. Further, if Contractor uses a subcontractor, Contractor shall require the subcontractor to comply with the requirements of Article 2 of Chapter 64 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

23. TERMINATION

County may terminate this Contract at any time without cause by giving thirty (30) days written notice to Contractor. Contractor may terminate this Contract at any time without cause by giving ninety (90) days written notice to County.

24. INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless County, its commissioners, employees, agents and representatives from any and all liabilities and claims of every kind, including attorney's fees, to which County may be subjected on account of loss, destruction or damage to property or injury to or death of persons, including Contractor and persons employed by Contractor, arising out of or in connection with the performance of this Contract. The provisions of this paragraph shall not be applicable to loss or damage caused by the negligent act of omission of County or its employees.

25. NOTICE

Any notice to be given shall be given in writing and delivered personally or by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid as follows:

26. ASSIGNABILITY

This Contract shall not be assigned or otherwise transferred by Contractor without the prior written consent of County.

27. SUBCONTRACTING

Contractor shall not subcontract any of the work contemplated under this Agreement without prior written approval from the County. Any approved subcontract shall be subject to all conditions of this Agreement. Only the subcontractors specified in the contract documents are to be considered approved upon award of the contract. The County shall not be obligated to pay for any work performed by any unapproved subcontractor. The Contractor shall be responsible for the performance of all of its subcontractors.

28. SIGNATURES

This Agreement, together with any amendments or modifications, may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall be considered one and the same agreement. This Agreement may also be executed electronically. By signing electronically, the parties indicate their intent to comply with the Electronic Commerce in Government Act (NCGS § 66-58.1 et seq.) and the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act (NCGS § 66-311 et seq.). Delivery of an executed counterpart of this Agreement by either electronic means or by facsimile shall be as effective as a manually executed counterpart.

29. SIGNATURE AUTHORITY

The individuals signing this Agreement hereby warrant that they have the legal authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the respective party, and that such binding authority has been granted by proper order, resolution, ordinance or other authorization of the entity. Each party is fully entitled to rely on these warranties and representations in entering into this Agreement or any amendment hereto.

30. CONFLICT OR INCONSISTENCY

In the event of any inconstancy, conflict or ambiguity among the terms and conditions of this Agreement, an attached scope of work, fee proposal, or other document relating to the Scope of Work or Services contemplated by this Agreement, the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement shall govern and control.

31. CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION AND COMPLIANCE

By signing this Agreement, Contractor certifies that it is qualified and capable to perform the Services, that it is financially able to perform the services timely, and that it knows of no existing or contemplated condition, obligation or obstruction that will prevent it from performing the Services. Contractor shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, ordinances, guidelines, and grant requirements and shall obtain all environmental and other applicable governmental permits applicable to this Agreement. Contractor hereby indemnifies County against any punitive or other action resulting from or associated with Contractor's failure to do so.

32. NON-DISCRIMINATION

Neither Party nor its employees will discriminate against any person based on race; religion; creed; color; sex; gender identity and expression; pregnancy; childbirth; breastfeeding; medical conditions related to pregnancy, childbirth, or breastfeeding; sexual orientation; marital status; age; national origin; ancestry; genetic information; disability; veteran status; low income status or any class protected by local, state, or federal law in the performance of this Agreement.
