Are You Using Your Free Digital Resources?

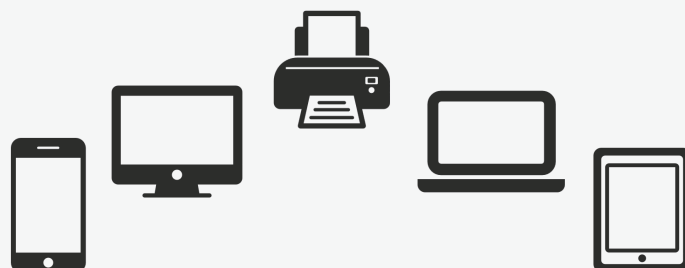
Wednesday, April 10 at 10 am
