## Return of firearms and ammunition seized during execution of Domestic Violence Protection Orders

If you are a defendant in a domestic violence case and have had your firearms and/or ammunition seized, you may have your firearms returned to you after the following requirements have been met.

- Your Domestic Violence Protective Order or Ex-Parte Order has expired or has been dismissed by a District Court or higher level Judge, and you have an Order from a Judge authorizing the Catawba County Sheriff to release your firearms/ammunition. (You can obtain this paperwork from the Clerk of Court or your attorney.)
- You are not under Indictment or have not been convicted of a crime punishable by imprisonment of more than one year, convicted of a crime of domestic violence, an unlawful user or are addicted to any controlled substance, and you have no history of mental defect or have been committed to any mental institution.
- You are not illegally and unlawfully residing in the United States.
- You have not been dishonorably discharged from any branch of the United States Armed Forces.
- You are prepared to pay the Sheriff of Catawba County a fee of <u>\$5.00 per month per firearm</u> for the storage of your firearms. This fee shall be paid in cash at the time of pickup.

## If all of the above requirements are met:

- Call the Catawba County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division at 828-465-8340 and ask to speak with the Evidence Technician to schedule an appointment. <u>Firearm returns are done by appointment only.</u>

## If one or more of the above requirements prevents the Sheriff's Office from returning your firearms:

- You may petition the Court to have your firearms transferred to a third party (friend, family, etc).
- You may petition the Court to hold a Hearing to argue your case before a Judge. (You must subpoena all relevant parties to the Hearing, including the Sheriff's Office Evidence Technician.)
- You may request in writing to have the firearms and/or ammunition turned over to the Catawba County Sheriff's Office for their use and training.

By law, the Sheriff's Office can petition the Court to <u>destroy your firearms</u> if you do not contact the Sheriff's Office within 90 days of the expiration of your Protective Order.
