CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Minutes of meeting held on July 26, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 8:15 A.M. Present were all members and the Director. The minutes from April 22, 2019, were approved. Unanimous votes were taken to approve the items as set forth below.

The City of Hickory will have a primary election on October 8, 2019, for Wards 1, 2, and 3. A single one-stop voting site, Highland Recreation Center, will be used for this primary. It will be operated on Mondays through Fridays from 8:00 am to 5:00 p.m. from September 18, 2019, through October 4, 2019. For this primary election, voters in Conover West, Mountain View 1, and Startown will be transferred to Sweetwater; and voters in St. Stephens 2 will be transferred to Sandy Ridge, leaving ten precincts to be operated on election day.

The municipal elections will be held on November 5, 2019. The one-stop voting site for Hickory will be Highland Recreation Center, and the one-stop voting site for all other municipalities in the county will be the Newton Main Library. The one-stop sites will be operated on Mondays through Fridays from 8:00 am to 5:00 p.m. from October 16, 2019, through November 1, 2019. For these municipal elections, voters in East Maiden will be transferred to Maiden; voters in Monogram will be transferred to Catawba; voters in Mountain View 1 and 2 will be transferred to Brookford; voters in St. Stephens 2 will be transferred to Sandy Ridge; and voters in Oxford will be transferred to Claremont.

The Board's next regular meeting will be held on August 20, 2019 at 8:15 a.m. to appoint precinct election officials and any other business. Regular meetings will be held at 8:15 a.m. on September 17 and 24, and on October 1 and 7, 2019, to approve absentee ballot applications and any other business. A special meeting will be held in the Board of Commissioners meeting room at 8:15 a.m. on August 1, 2019, for the hearing on challenges to candidates for offices in the Town of Catawba.
