

CATAWBA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS

Minutes of meeting held on November 15, 2019

The meeting to conduct the county canvass was called to order at 11:00 a.m. Members Cheney, Abernethy, Hood, and White, and the Director, were present. The minutes from November 4 and 5, 2019, were approved.

The Board approved and counted five supplemental absentee ballots, all of which were timely received.

The Board counted the write-in votes for candidates who received at least five such votes.

The Board considered the fifteen provisional ballots. Five were approved, and one was partially approved, as the voter lived in the school district but the voter's house was shown on the county tax map to be outside the municipal limits. The rest were not counted, as the voter either was not registered or had already voted.

The vote totals by candidate are as shown on the attached computer printout printed today consisting of two pages titled "November 05, 2019 Municipal Election Results by Contest".

In the town of Maiden mayor contest, the results were Bumgarner 182, Rembert 170, and Hudson 178. The Board received a handwritten, signed request by Hudson for a recount. The recount will be conducted on Friday, November 22, 2019, at 8:15 a.m.

The voter history was reconciled with the number of ballots counted, and the results were the same.


The Board approved the one-stop voting schedule for the March 3, 2020 primary election. The five one-stop voting sites remain the same and will operate Feb. 13 through Feb. 29. The Monday through Friday hours will be 8:00 a.m. through 7:30 p.m. as mandated by statute. The Saturday hours will remain 8 a.m. through 3 p.m., and the Sunday hours will remain 8 a.m. through 3 p.m..

The Board discussed and approved the purchase of forty-five ESS voting booths and forty Franklin MXB voting booths.

The Board office will move in the near future to the renovated former animal shelter building. Construction is scheduled to be completed by December 20, and the move is to take place during the first week in January.

The meeting adjourned at 12:07 p.m.
