# 2022 CATAWBA COUNTY MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

The elections for City of Hickory and Town of Long View are delayed until 2022 as set forth by [NCGA Session Law 2021-56 Senate Bill 722](#)

**Municipal Election Day – Tuesday, March 8, 2022** (Absentee Ballots Allowed)  
This will be the same day as the Statewide 2022 Primary

If any Hickory seat requires a primary (more than 2 candidates per seat), the Hickory Primary will be held March 8<sup>th</sup> with the Hickory General Election coinciding with the 2022 Statewide 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary (either April 26 or May 17)

**FILING PERIOD: Noon Dec 6, 2021 – Noon Dec 17, 2021 (10 business days)**

**FILING PERIOD: Noon Jan 3, 2022 – Noon Jan 7, 2022 (5 business days)**
