TRAIL ETIQUETTE

- **Ride on open trails only**
- **Leave no trace:** Stay on existing trails. Be sure to pack out your trash. Don't hike or ride on soft or muddy trails.
- **Control your bicycle:** Inattention could put yourself and others at unnecessary risk.
- **Always yield trail:** Bicyclists yield to other trail users. Hikers and runners moving uphill have the right of way.
- **Make yourself known:** Let fellow trail users know you're coming. Offer a hello or give a head nod. This helps create a friendly atmosphere on the trail.
- **Be aware of your surroundings**
- **Treat other trail users as you want to be treated**
- **Respect the wildlife and lands**

1	Stormie Normie	.9	●	MULTI-USE. Paved ADA trail to the lakefront and upper south side amenities.
2	Sunday Stroll	.58	●	HIKERS ONLY. Close to parking, access to greater trail system.
3	Sherrills Pass	1.43	●	MULTI-USE. Primary trail system access.
4	Aww Shucks	.43	●	MULTI-USE. Singletrack connector to bike trails.
5	Terrells Folly	.29	●	BIKES ONLY. One-way primary route for mountain bikers to enter the trail system.
6	Oh Deer!	.62	●	BIKES ONLY. One-way singletrack with dirt rollers, berms, and rolling ups and downs.
7	Milk and Honey	.58	●	MULTI-USE. One-way singletrack leading back to park entrance.
8	Loblolly Loop	2.52	●	MULTI-USE. Rolling forested loop with creek and stream views. Spur connector to northern trails.
9	Dutch Oven	.33	■	BIKES ONLY. Tight and twisty flowing singletrack with berms.
10	Tomtastic	.17	■	MULTI-USE. Rolling trail around historic old hunting pond.
11	Jug Town Jump	.12	●	MULTI-USE. Short connector trail to extend or shorten the south loop.
12	Mt. Creek Loop	5.26	● ■	MULTI-USE. Circles the northern section and features creeks, bridges and lakeshore.
13	Wampus Way	.84	●	MULTI-USE. Access route from connector bridge to primary central trail hub.
14	Haymaker	.30	■ ◆	BIKES ONLY. Multiple table tops, rock jumps, rollers, berms, and rock garden.
15	Old Boozy	1.26	● ■	MULTI-USE. Rolling forested singletrack.
16	Ladderback	.64	●	MULTI-USE. Connector trail from northernmost trail section to central trail hub.
17	Hot Hole	.36	■	BIKES ONLY. One-way downhill flow with rollers, berms, optional rock drops on some of the best elevation.
18	Baked Possum	.29	■	BIKES ONLY. Swooping single track flow with rollers, berms and rocky step-downs.
19	Rabbit Race	.32	● ■	BIKES ONLY. Brief climb yields to downhill single-track trail with berms and rollers.
20	Iron Lung	.82	●	MULTI-USE. Connector trail to northern trailhead.
21	Cable Ferry	.16	●	MULTI-USE. Shortcut to return to top of bike-only trails.
22	Miners Run	.79	●	BIKES ONLY. Fast, rolling, one-way singletrack connector trail.
23	Shiners Stash	.24	■ ◆	BIKES ONLY. Descending flow over rollers, jumps, drops, berms, and gullies.
24	Puddle Jump	.27	■	BIKES ONLY. Swooping singletrack with rollers, berms, optional drops and sweeping turns.

welcome to mountain creek park!

Located on the northwestern tip of Lake Norman in Sherrills Ford, this 606-acre park features an extensive 19.52-mile trail network and a host of other amenities including an adventure playground, a mountain bike skills course and tool stations, pickleball courts, a dog park, fishing pier, canoe/kayak launch, an outdoor classroom, an observation platform, picnic shelters and a paved ADA-accessible trail that winds through a quiet cove.

Mountain biking is at the heart of Mountain Creek Park. Along with dedicated bike-only trails and endless route variations within the trail system, Mountain Creek Park is destined to quickly become a regional mountain biking destination.

PARK RULES

Please observe our park rules to ensure your visit is safe and enjoyable.
Thank you for helping us protect our natural heritage.

- Camping and Fires:** Camping is not allowed. Fires are only allowed in designated grills.
- Safety gear:** Wearing a helmet and any necessary safety gear when bike riding is recommended.
- Dogs:** Must have a valid rabies tag. Dogs outside the fenced dog park must be on a leash.
- Children:** Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Lake Access:** No swimming or wading.
- Trash:** Please throw trash in proper receptacles located throughout the park.
- Fishing:** Permitted only during park hours in designated areas or fishing pier. NC Wildlife Resources Commission regulations apply.
- Drones:** Not allowed.
- Motorized Vehicles:** Class 1, pedal-assist E-bikes are permitted. All other motorized vehicles are not permitted.
- Guns and Fireworks:** Fireworks, firearms and all other weapons are not allowed. Carrying legally permitted concealed handguns in Catawba County Parks is allowed.
- Natural Resources:** The removal of any plant, animal or artifact is not allowed.
- Hunting and Trapping:** Not allowed. All Catawba County Parks are wildlife reserves.
- Alcohol and Smoking:** Smoking and the possession or drinking of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.

PARK FACILITIES FEES

Annual Dog Park Pass = \$20 per dog
Open Shelter Reservation = \$20 per hour; 2-hour minimum
Education/Meeting Facility = \$100/half-day; \$150/full-day + \$50 refundable deposit

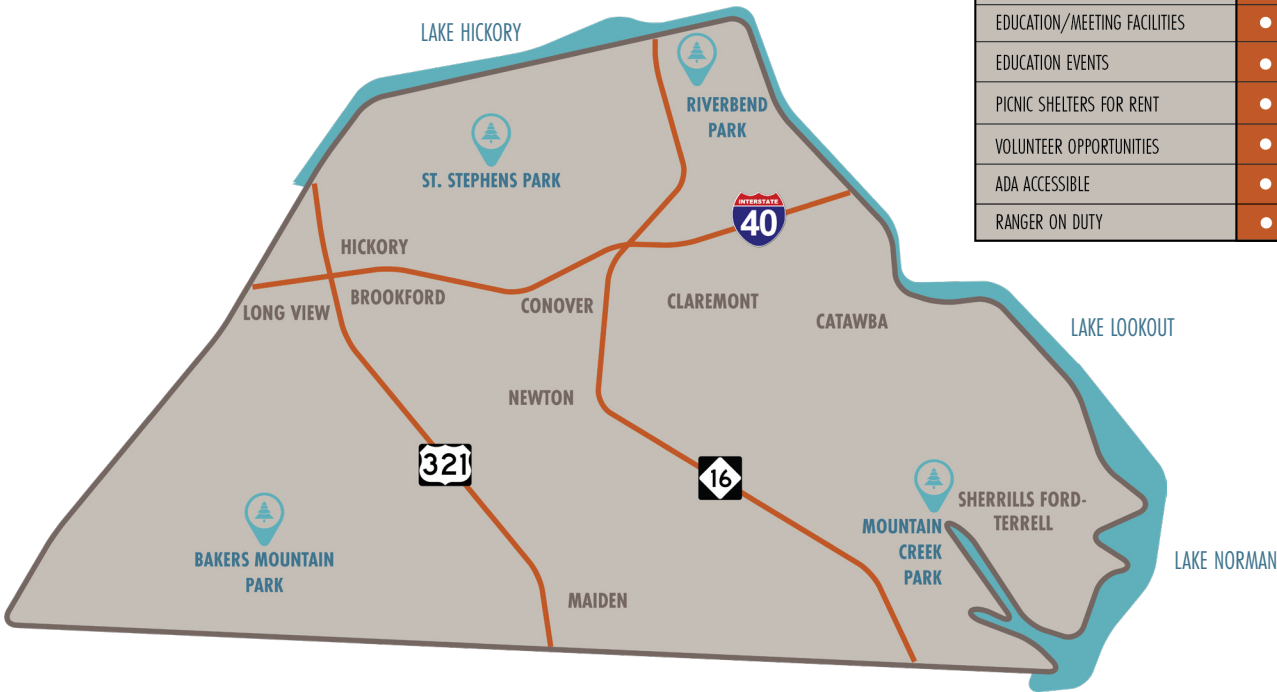
