



Catawba County Motor Vehicle Appeal Form

G.S 105-283 requires all property in North Carolina be appraised at market value. For motor vehicles, market value is defined as the total retail price, which includes delivery and dealer preparation costs. Vehicles are assigned an average retail value, assuming the subject vehicle is in average condition with average mileage. In accordance with G.S 105-330, vehicle registrations that are expiring or purchased during January through August are valued at average retail as of January 1st of the current calendar year. Vehicle registrations that are expiring or purchased during September through December are valued at average retail as of January 1st of the following year.
