

In 2019, the library embarked on a Strategic Planning project where we gathered the opinions of over 700 Catawba County residents through focus groups, community forums, surveys, and interviews. The resulting strategic plan with goals to Connect, Explore and Grow aims to respond to our community's diverse needs as we are work to enhance the quality of library facilities, spaces, technologies, and resources to entice exploration, spark curiosity, foster lifelong learning, and enhance quality of life.

With a focus on libraries as destinations, we have recently renovated the St. Stephens Branch Library with new interactive experiences for our youngest learners, new user friendly shelving,

meeting and gathering spaces, and new computer work stations. The result is a vibrant, welcoming library space for all ages to enjoy. Community members can stop by the St. Stephens Branch anytime during normal operating hours to check out all the changes.

Everyone is invited to a special ribbon cutting celebration on Wednesday, December 8th at 9 am where we will showcase the updated St. Stephens Branch. We hope you will join us to see the space, learn about library services, try out a new technology, and enjoy light refreshments!

With help from grant funding administered by the State Library of North Carolina, the library has been able to address another strategic initiative to provide our community access to the latest technologies for education, business and personal goals.

The library has also modernized our meeting rooms and study spaces with private and safe video-conferencing technology. This access allows the community to have a space for virtual meetings, interviews, doctor visits, and more without the burden of purchasing equipment, establishing internet access, or worrying about security and privacy. These spaces are available for reservation now and trained library employees are available to help people get started.

A separate grant from the State allowed the library system to purchase gaming systems to enhance teen programming while providing access to the latest technologies. Teens should be on the lookout for Teen Game Night programs at their local branch where they will be able to connect with their friends in a safe environment while they play on a Nintendo Switch or with a Meta Quest 2 VR headset. Teens can enjoy games like Mario Kart 8, Mario Party, Sing 2021, and Sports on the Nintendo Switches and Beat Saber, Job Simulator, and Cooking Simulator on the Meta Quest 2 VR headsets. These systems are only available for use during supervised teen programs.



This month the library is excited to announce the launch of a new software program called Interplay Learning that will provide free, webbased training for trade skills including plumbing, electrician, HVAC repair, solar installation, and more. While all of the training can be completed online with a regular computer, laptop, or tablet, it also has simulations and virtual reality (VR) lessons that allow for virtual on-thejob experience and skills evaluations. Interplay Learning participants will be able to visit the library and use Meta Quest 2 VR headsets to complete simulation lessons and evaluations. Stay

tuned for details on how to register for classes using the Interplay Learning software.


